MORNING DROP OFF/END OF DAY PICK UP

The speed limit in the parking lot both before and after school is 5 mph. Recently we have noticed that a number of cars are exceeding the speed limit of 5 mph in the parking lot. This presents a dangerous situation for our students; we are asking all drivers to comply with the speed limit for the safety of our students and the staff who man the parking lot. Distracted driving while on a cell phone when driving through the parking lot is also dangerous. Please refrain from using your mobile device when driving; feel free to park and talk or take/send messages.

END OF QUARTER/REPORT CARDS

As we draw closer to the end of the first quarter of school, we want to remind parents that report cards will be sent home with students on Friday, November 1. In order for your child to receive a report cards, all accounts and fees must be up to date. This includes registration/technology fees, overdue library books, AfterCare fees and late pick-up fees.

COSI AT OLA

COSI (Center for Science and Industry) will bring their mobile classroom to OLA on Tuesday, December 17, 2019. This program will be an in-school field trip for students in grades K-6. Many parents volunteers are needed to make this program a success. Volunteers are needed on Monday, December 16

for set-up as well as on December 17 throughout the day. In order to volunteer, please make sure you are part of our volunteer data base; if not, see the information below to become an OLA volunteer.

VOLUNTEERING AT OLA

As class field trips become a reality for our K-8 students, please remember that any parent, grandparent or guardian who would like to accompany a class must be compliant with our volunteer requirements prior to the date of the field trip. In order to work with any group of students or accompany them on field trips, volunteers must be Virtus trained with OLA listed as the organization with whom they are associated, two mandatory documents must be read and sign-off pages for each provided to the school, and BCII fingerprint background checks must be done with results sent directly to OLA. We cannot accept fingerprint records from employers or other organizations. Fingerprints must be recorded every five years; if you have prints on record that are outdated, you will have to provide new records to OLA. Volunteers who have been Virtus trained elsewhere should add OLA to the list of organizations for affiliation.

Once all of these requirements are met, individuals will be eligible to act as volunteers. All of these requirements are part of the safety structure put in place to keep our students safe. Thank you for your understanding and compliance.

LATE PICK-UP

Thank you to all parents/guardians who have picked up their children in a timely manner since school started. According to the Parent/Student Handbook, any student not picked up by 3 pm is brought to the main school office where he/she may wait until 3:15. After 3:15 pm a late fee is charged; students picked up between 3:15-3:30 will be charged \$10; after that the charge increase by \$10 for every 10 minutes. The same is followed on Compressed Days when dismissal is at 1:50 pm.
