END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES

Following the guidance of the Cleveland Department of Health, the State of Ohio Health Department, and the CDC our end-of-year activities will look different this year. During the last week of school all classes will have the opportunity to have a modified Sports Day as part of their PE classes. Any class picnic will be on a very small scale with all students bringing a bag lunch; no food may be shared or sent in by parents. Teachers may coordinate plans with others at the same grade level, and outdoor activities will be included as much as possible. The traditional 8th grade Clap Out will take place, but students will be recognized and “clapped out” from inside the building. As 8th grade students leave the building, they will immediately be dismissed. Please contact Mrs. Krupar with any questions or concerns rather than asking teachers as all plans are subject to change with only a day’s notice.

The dress code for the last week of school is the usual school uniform; students are encouraged to wear uniform shorts with an OLA top/shirt on the day their class will have its sports/picnic day and any cleaning day. They may bring athletic shoes to change into, but they must wear school shoes to school each day.

LAST DAY OF SCHOOL

The last day of school this year is Friday, May 28, 2021. There is an 11:30 am dismissal this day. **Students are expected to be dressed in uniform on the last day.** No lunch time will be scheduled, nor will lunch be served. Please make arrangements for your child to be picked up in a timely manner or walk home that day. Report cards will be sent home electronically on Friday, June 4 to all families that are up-to-date with fees. There will not be any After Care. **All students should be picked up no later than 11:45.**

FINAL REPORT CARDS

The final report card of the 2020-2021 school year will be sent out electronically on Friday, June 4 via Digital Academy. All accounts must be up-to-date in order to have access to report cards.
